



## Math Grades for Junior High and High School

- All of the assignments of each chapter must be completed before taking the test.
- Grades are based on an average of the percentages achieved on tests, the quarterly grade for class preparedness, and the quarterly letter grade for daily assignments.
- At the discretion of the teacher and principal approval the daily requirements can be modified for an individual student. Students and parents will be clearly informed of any change.

### Chapter Grades

Chapter grades are based on the test grade earned for each chapter as follows:

A+	100%
A	90-99%
B	80-89%
C	70-79%
D	60-69%
E	< than 60%

If a student earns a "C", "D", or "E" on a test, the teacher has the discretion to have the student re-do part of the chapter and repeat the test, re-do the whole chapter and the test, or have the student repeat lessons back to where understanding was complete. If a test needs to be re-taken, the new grade earned will be averaged in along with the old test grade.

### Daily Written Work

- Daily assignments should be completed in class.
- If the student does not complete the daily assignment during class it will be considered homework and needs to be turned in no later than the following day at 8:30 a.m.
- Daily assignments turned in after 8:30 a.m. will be counted as late.
- Class preparation is defined as having all the materials necessary for math ready to begin working within the first two minutes of the period.
- Letter grades will be adjusted if necessary according to the amount of times daily assignments are turned in late during the quarter and how many times a student is unprepared for class.
- Daily assignments, in order to be accepted as complete must:
  - Have a score of 80% or higher
  - Work is neat and up to class expectations

**Semester Grades**

Semester grades are the numeric average of all the chapter tests, daily assignments, and class preparedness grades converted to a whole letter grade per the scale for the chapter grades.

Quarterly grades are computed identically to semester grades except they are expressed more granularly.

Averages are calculated to two decimal places and rounded up at .50 and above.
