- through clear expectations and hard work our teachers are able to support our parents in fostering excellence in spiritual, intellectual, and physical development.

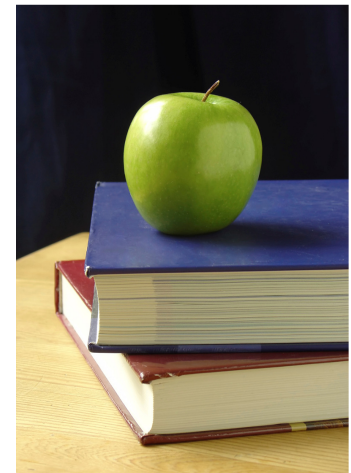

Philosophy of Education

Our faith is rooted in the belief that Jesus is the Son of God, who through His death and resurrection, those who believe in Him have eternal life with Him. We hold to the Bible as the inerrant word of God. Our teaching of the Bible to our students is built on reading the scriptures and its teachings in the context of the passage. Our Bible classes in kindergarten through twelfth grade spend the majority of their lessons reading from the Bible. Students are to graduate with a thorough and practical knowledge of God enabling them to practically live their lives and witness their faith.

The closest description of our teaching methods would be individual activity based. **Think of it as a very organized, purpose driven - with years of experience behind it - homeschool approach to educating.** There is very little lecture in our school.

Instead, in classes of around fifteen/sixteen students, each student completes his or her individual goals in a uniquely planned curriculum throughout all the grades. The teachers are much more than a lecturer passing information. At Bios, teacher and student meet two to six times during each subject for instruction, accountability, confirmation, correction, and direction.

The overall objective of the Bios rigorous academic program is to teach students strong skills of analysis and expression; to instill a core knowledge in the sciences, humanities, and arts; to foster the ability to think creatively, critically, and independently; and to instill a passion for learning. Bios offers a strong group of classes designed to allow each individual student to grow to their potential.

Bios Christian offers experienced teachers who provide clear expectations and the knowledge of how to effectively teach each student under their care while supporting the parents in their responsibility to train their children.

Choosing a school to entrust your son's or daughter's education with is a very important decision. Bios offers a very unique, Christian education - an education which works to support the parents in their training of their children while preparing the boys and girls for both the rigors of college and of life.

So why Bios? We are committed to a value system which at its core is the Bible, the infallible word of God. In addition, a rigorous college prep curriculum, with two AP courses already included, is set to provide the skills needed to allow each student to prepare for college.

Our teaching of the Bible comes from the belief that it is God breathed and basic for life training. Our daily Bible classes are taught directly from the Bible in kindergarten through eighth grades. Teachers interpret passages within the parameters of context, inerrancy, and Christ-centeredness. In high school, students spend additional time reading and discussing the thoughts of authors such as MacArthur, Sproul and others.

A developing arts and sports program is an essential aspect of the life of students attending Bios. Physical education is expected daily in kindergarten through tenth grades. In the first through ninth grades, students participate in a string orchestra, performing on stage at two performances each year. Our school participates in junior high/high school sports through AICS. AICS is a small school Christian athletic league involving schools located in the valley.

All of the above mentioned reasons are important parts of Bios. But what truly sets Bios apart is the caring, excellent group of teachers and staff who work diligently to support our parents in the training of their children.
